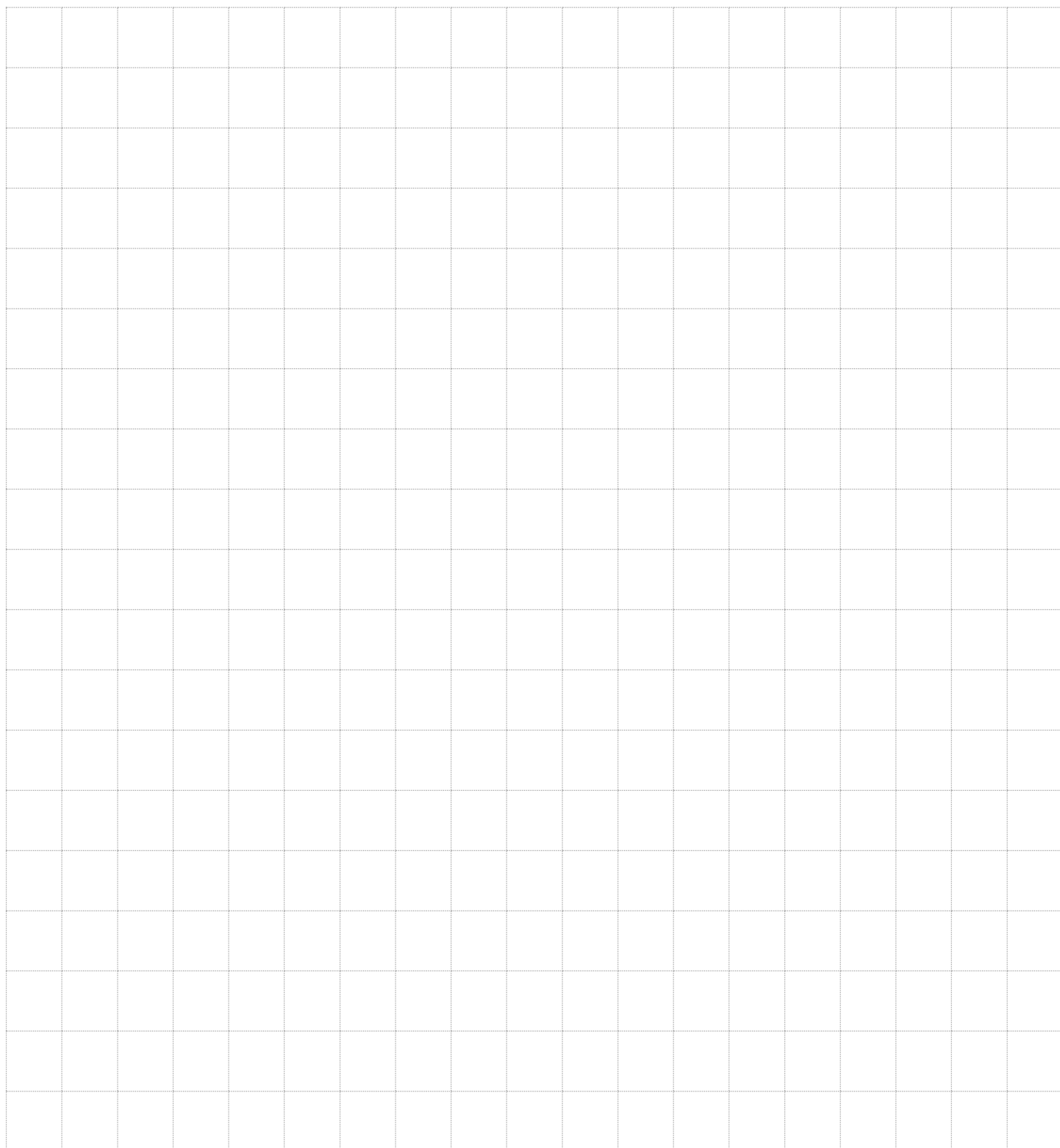

Background information

Number of plants per m²

The number of plants needed for a border strongly depends on the soil type and the type of planting: poor soils will require the maximum number, while rich soils for tallgrass prairie will only need the minimal number.

Usage of inert mulching layer

An inert mulching layer is not indispensable for a garden. However, given that most people like to reduce maintenance, we advise to use lava 2/8. The extra advantages are that the lava will insulate in the winter, when walking on or working in the border you will not compress the ground and it improves the supply of oxygen and minerals.
